The CoC determined that the project should be reduced due to insufficient expenditures and drawdowns. In 2020-2021, \$82,000 was recaptured by HUD. In the most recent fiscal year, their drawdowns were also very low, with the expectation of likely recapture.

The project applicant was notified about the reduction initially on 8/31/2023; on 9/5/2023, the applicant was notified that the decision was final, following the completion of the local competition appeals period.

The recommendation for reallocation was made by the CoC's Review and Rank Committee (RRC), which was established to review all project applications submitted in the 2023 local competition and comprised non-conflicted CoC members. The recommendation of the RRC was reviewed and ratified by the CoC Board's Executive Committee.
